

Comply With the USP <800> Enforceable Standard

As an enforceable standard, the USP <800> General Chapter for Hazardous Drugs Handling in Healthcare Settings applies to all healthcare personnel who receive, prepare, administer, transport or otherwise come in contact with hazardous drugs and all the environments in which they are handled. Use this at-a-glance guide to maintain compliance in your facility.

Identify



- ✓ Create/review hazardous drug (HD) inventory
- ✓ Designate someone to administer and manage the program
- ✓ Complete an assessment of risk for every HD:
 - Annually
 - When HD is new to your facility (prior to receipt is best practice)
 - When new information is available (on/off the NIOSH list)

- ✓ Maintain up-to-date safety data sheets
- ✓ Create standard operating procedures (SOPs) to include:
 - Safe work/handling practices
 - Facility and engineering controls
 - Policies for HD waste segregation and disposal

Train



- ✓ Ensure competent personnel with annual training including:
 - Overview of HDs in facility and risks
 - Review of SOPs related to HD handling
 - HD spill management and disposal
 - Proper use of PPE and equipment (engineering controls)
 - Response to known or suspected HD exposure

- ✓ Assess adverse event reports
- ✓ Track exposures, improper handling, and near misses
- ✓ Identify and evaluate new HDs
- ✓ Evaluate employee competency from training
- ✓ Complete employee health monitoring

- ✓ Provide additional training on risk issues identified
- ✓ Elicit feedback from staff on their perception of HD safety
- ✓ Review regulatory standards and best practices
- ✓ Document employee review and receipt of SOPs
