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
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Overview of Congestive Heart Failure


Congestive Heart Failure (CHF) is a complex syndrome resulting in the heart's inability to effectively pump oxygenated blood to the brain, organs and muscles. This ineffective circulation **leads to fluid retention in the body and causes the heart to overcompensate** when there are increased demands on it.

Symptoms like these can result in unplanned hospital readmissions. Although CHF affects people of all ages, it is the leading cause of readmissions in adults over the age of 65. Sixty-one percent of CHF readmissions occur within the first 15 days, and in the long-term care setting, 27-43% of readmission rates are caused by heart failure alone.

CHF and Readmissions

Over 6 million adults in the U.S. have CHF

50% will die within 5 years of diagnosis

75% of those affected have at least one comorbidity

(e.g., hypertension, diabetes, stroke, obesity, sleep apnea, or cardiovascular disease)



CHF costs more than annually

CHF and Readmissions

More than 870,000 new cases of CHF are diagnosed each year, and with no identified cure, **evidence-based practice must be used** to manage the condition.

To reduce the likelihood of CHF readmissions:

- Ensure appropriate discharge planning
- · Create an individualized, patient-centered care plan
- Properly reconcile patient medication
- Provide adequate patient and caregiver education
- · Promote strong clinical competency regarding disease management
- Schedule physician follow-up appointments or ancillary referrals

Post-acute care providers should also **focus on symptom relief** to reduce readmission rates associated with CHF, and thus improve overall patient outcomes.

For every 100 Medicare patients admitted to a hospital within a 30-day period,

24.5% were admitted because of CHF





Symptoms of CHF

Pay careful attention to the signs of CHF. They may worsen suddenly or gradually over time. Worsening of symptoms, commonly known as an exacerbation, should be properly addressed by clinicians.

If the following symptoms occur in a patient, seek help immediately.



Shortness of breath



Diminished capacity for exercise



Swelling in legs, ankles and feet



Sudden weight gain from fluid retention



Rapid or irregular heartbeat



Fatigue and weakness

Discharge Planning

Utilize discharge planning tools:

- · Facility readiness assessments
- Hospital to post-acute transfer forms
- · Post-acute care capabilities checklists
- Medication reconciliation worksheets

Clinical Competency

- · Create a patient-centered care plan
- Perform a complete physical assessment to establish a baseline and help identify signs and symptoms of early CHF exacerbation
- Monitor for indicators of fluid retention, such as edema, persistent cough or Orthopnea/Paroxysmal Nocturnal Dyspnea (PND)
- · Increase understanding of clinical guidelines for managing CHF

Patient Screening

Screen symptomatic patients with common comorbidities. Perform diagnostic testing, including a complete physical assessment, medication review and labs.

Nutrition

- · Ensure patients adhere to fluid restriction of 1.5-2 L
- For patients taking nutritional supplements, promote calorically dense products that will not negatively impact other disease states
- Recommend nutritional options without extra sodium or glucose that replenish electrolytes



Education



Educate patients and caregivers on:

- Indication, dosage, schedule and side effects of medications
- Communicate patient dietary needs and restrictions
- Routinely monitor patient weight
- Stress importance of good oral hygiene
- Recommend therapeutic exercise

OTC Medication



- Prescribe multi-vitamins and supplements
- Recommend smoking cessation
- Manage CHF side effects, like dry skin and muscle aches



CHF Exacerbation Screening and Diagnostic Criteria

Prevention and Management

- Temp >100.5
- Apical HR >100 or <50
- Respirator Rate >28 or <10
- Systolic BP <90 or >200
- Oxygen Saturation <90
- Weight Gain >3lbs in 2 days or >5lbs 72h
- Fingerstick Glucose <70 or >300
- New or Worsening Chest Pain

Indicators

- Blood Pressure
- Pulse
- Respiratory Rate
- Temperature
- Weight Loss
- Weight Gain



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Diagnosing a CHF exacerbation is generally focused on fluid retention. It is widely believed that the symptoms of fluid overload are evident as much as a week before hospitalization. However, some patients do not admit to symptoms to avoid a return to the hospital – often making their situation worse.

If CHF symptoms are present, a full patient assessment should be completed. The patient's medical history should be reviewed, medication compliance should be confirmed, and the physician should be notified of all abnormal assessment results.

Signs and Symptoms of CHF

Symptoms of Fluid Overload

- · Weight Gain
 - 3 lbs in one day
 - 5 lbs in one week
- Dyspnea at rest
- · Paroxysmal Nocturnal Dyspnea
 - Pillow propping
 - Increased nocturnal urination
- · Wheezing/Rales/Abnormal breath sounds
- Peripheral or sacral edema
- Jugular venous distension
- Use of accessory muscles to breath

Confusion/anxiety

Chest pain

Palpitations – stimulation of SNS response

Anorexia, early satiety – resulting from decreased GI perfusion

Unstable vital signs

- Temp >100.5
- Apical HR >100 or <50
- Respirator Rate >28 or <10
- Systolic BP <90 or >200
- Oxygen Saturation <90

What to Do

Complete full assessment Review patient history

- · Check blood glucose if diabetic
- Review I/O
- Confirm low sodium diet adherence – notify dietician if not

Confirm medication compliance or administration

Confirm medication profile includes:

- ACEI/ARB/ARNI
 - e.g., Lisinopril, Diovan
- Aldosterone antagonist
 - e.g., Aldactone
- Diuretic
 - e.g., Lasix, Bumex
- Beta blocker
 - e.g., Coreg, Toprol
- Hydralazine-nitrate
 - e.g., BiDil

Notify doctor of all abnormal assessment results and any deficiencies/non-compliance

Inform and educate patient, family or caregiver

Further diagnostic testing may be requested to include labs (BNP, CMP, CBC, INR, and Blood Glucose) and a portable chest x-ray or an EKG

Stay in Facilty

- Monitor patient vital signs and input/output every 4 to 8 hours
- · Monitor electrolytes and renal function
- Provide supplemental oxygen, if necessary
- Consider:
 - Increasing dosage of diuretics
 - Increasing other cardiac medications to optimize use and efficacy
 - Use of a portable chest x-ray
- Update advance care plan and directives
